ESI FAIRFAX COUNTY CHECKLISTS UPDATED

In collaboration with Fairfax County, ESI has updated its Fairfax County ESI Checklists (dated 10/1/2020) for ESI member use in submitting plans to the County through the ESI Peer Review Process. Beginning November 1, 2020, ESI switched over to the new checklists and will no longer accept prior checklist versions for new submissions. Plans that are already in process as of November 1, 2020 may continue using the prior checklist version. BALANCING DPE PLAN QUALITY AND FAIRFAX COUNTY PLAN REVIEW COMMENTS

Do you have input on which Fairfax County plan review comments "make sense" to you? Do you want to be part of a dialog where Fairfax County offers examples of "deal breaker" mistakes that they find in DPE plans, especially 2nd submission DPE plans? The DPE Plan Quality and County Review Comments Committee's mission is to help Fairfax County balance its needs for DPE plan quality and submitters' needs for speed, consistency and predictability. The final product should be materials that the committee can share with ESI and Fairfax County reviewers that will increase mutual agreement on what is an acceptable plan. In addition, the committee will discuss modernizing the electronic review process to facilitate making decisions on the 2nd DPE submission workflow. The committee will determine its meeting frequency, but the kickoff meeting will occur after the ESI Fairfax Committee meeting on November 25, 2020. ESI FAIRFAX COUNTY PROJECT APPLICATION UPDATE

An update was made to the ESI Application for Fairfax County projects in an effort to clarify misunderstandings regarding the number of pages in a plan. We have encountered a lot of confusion from engineers over what constitutes a "development condition," which has led to many applications being filled out incorrectly, and subsequently, led to firms either overpaying or underpaying the fee for their project. Wording on the Fairfax ESI application has

been changed, and the term "development condition" has been replaced with "zoning plan." We hope that the changes to our application will better define what sheets need to be counted in their submission. We would also like to encourage all submitting engineers to download a fresh copy of the ESI application for the jurisdiction being submitted to for each plan, as minor changes or updates to the applications are sometimes made without announcement. We appreciate your understanding.
